EBA BUSINESS PROJECTS COORDINATOR PARTICIPATED IN THE SIGI REGIONAL POLICY DIALOGUE FOR EASTERN EUROPE AND THE CAUCASUS AS A SPEAKER FOR THE DISCUSSION ON WOMEN'S ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT IN EURASIA.

The OECD Development Centre, the Austrian Development Cooperation and UN Women hosted a Regional Policy Dialogue for Eastern Europe and the Caucasus in Tbilisi on May 15 and EBA Business Projects' Coordinator Ms. Hermine Fanyan was a panelist. The event launched the Social Institutions and Gender Index (SIGI) 2019 Regional Report for Eurasia and inform policy debates on social norms and discrimination against women and girls across the region.

The women economic empowerment panel represented an important occasion to learn how different countries in Eastern Europe and the Caucasus are addressing this issue and how these action can help contribute to achieving not only Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) 5.5 but the entire 2030 Agenda. The rich and dynamic exchanges between the panellists provided the audience with critical insights into the challenges to foster women's economic empowerment in the region as well as the good practices that contribute to reshaping gender norms and discriminatory social institutions, bolstering the regional efforts to achieve gender equality by 2030.

EBA shared its experience in Armenia and expertise on barriers faced by women in Yerevan based on the survey on major impediments for women entrepreneurs and explore women's rights gaps in business activity of Armeniain in 2018.







EBA ARMENIA HAD A MEETING WITH INTERNATIONAL EXPERT ON THE INSTITUTIONALIZATION OF PUBLIC-PRIVATE DIALOGUE PLATFORM

European Business Association Armenia, its Member EY Armenia and AmCham Armenia had a meeting with an independent expert Mr. Tim Vickery who has been asked by the EBRD to advise on the institutionalization of public-private dialogue platform between the government and the private sector to ensure a favorable business environment and enhance the investment climate.
