On November 20, EBA Armenia organized Round Table on Tax Administration and Legislation awareness in the scope of the EU funded Project "Strengthening EU Business Development in Armenia". Public officials, international organization representatives, embassies, EBA Members, partners and potential members have attended the event. DWV German Business Association's and Armenian-Italian Chamber of Commerce's members have also attended the event. For about 100 international and local large, medium and small companies attended the Round Table. Three days regional meeting of the European Business Organization World Wide Network (EBO WWN) took place for the first time in Tokyo from 2 to 4 December at the EU Delegation in Japan. The meeting was organized by European Business Council Japan and gathered EBO members from more than 30 countries as well as representatives of the EU Commission, local and international businesses and local and national Japanese authorities. Her Excellency EU Ambassador to Japan Ms. Patricia Flor and the major/governor of Tokyo Ms. Yuriko Koike have attended the meeting and made opening speeches. EBA Armenia executive director Ms. Diana Sarumova represented Armenia during the meeting.

One of the reasons for choosing Tokyo as the venue of the EBO WWN 2019 regional meeting has been the recent implementation of the EU-Japan Economic Partnership Agreement, the largest and most advanced free trade agreement in the world. During the meeting, the general discussion was focused on the features of the Japanese economy in its maturity stage. Of considerable interest were the discussions on the expansion of the existing sustainable and high-quality cooperation between EU and Japanese businesses in third countries within the framework of the recently signed Connectivity agreement between EU and Japan. In closed sessions and workshops the EBOs have discussed governance, best practices in advocacy and the possibility of regional cooperation among them.

Mr. Francesco Formiconi, EBC Japan's Executive Director, declared that the meeting was a great success and that the Network showed great growth potential great influence in the undergoing trade treaty negotiations of the EU all around the world.

On 4-6 Decmber, the 11th Annual Assembly – "EaP4EU: Joining forces for a win-win partnership" was held in Brussels, hosting over 300 civil society representatives from the EaP region and the EU as well as international stakeholders, key decision makers and journalists.

Olivér Várhelyi, the newly appointed Commissioner for Neighbourhood and Enlargement Negotiations opened the conference, stressing the importance of empowering civil society and strengthening its role at all levels of policy making in order to support better democratic processes and resilience in the Eastern Partnership countries.

More than 25 Brussels based stakeholders, think tankers and experts debated with EaP CSF representatives in a participatory World Café format the key ideas EaP CSF submitted to the structured consultation. This major issue became the focus of the high-level panel Future of the EaP: challenges ahead and enabling civil society, featuring the State Minister for Reconciliation and Civic Equality, Georgia - Ketevan Tsikhelashvili, Minister of Justice of Armenia - Rustam Badasyan, Director, Russia, Eastern Partnership, Central Asia, Regional cooperation and OSCE, EEAS - Luc Devigne and the Director Neighbourhood East and Institution Building, DG NEAR, European Commission - Lawrence Meredith.

As the highest decision-making body of the EaP CSF, the General Assembly adopted the new Statute of the Forum (ENG, RU), which will allow the Forum to make a next step in implementation of its ambitious internal reform focusing on ethical standards, transparency and accountability. The General Assembly also adopted the Forum's 11th Annual Assembly Declaration (ENG, RU), with recommendations aimed at the future of the EaP policy and preparations of the sixth Eastern Partnership Summit coming up in 2020.


